

## COVID-19 Hygiene- & Protection measures

## Dear friends and dear guests of Schweibenalp

As of 13 September, the **certificate obligation** now also applies to indoor areas of (hotel) bars and restaurants as well as to indoor events.

As the business or organiser concerned, the Schweibenalp Centre of Unity has the task of checking the Covid certificates of event participants, hotel guests and restaurant visitors.

The Covid certificate is available to vaccinated, recovered and negatively tested persons. It can be presented in an app ("COVID Certificate" app) or in paper form.

The nearest Covid testing facility is the Interlaken Drive-in Test Centre on the Jungfrau Park grounds.

Furthermore, masks must be worn in all buildings as follows:

- · At the reception and in our store
- · In the passages and staircase
- In the seminar rooms until you have arrived at your seat
- In the dining room to your seat
- In the toilets and the waiting area of the shared showers

Furthermore, at Schweibenalp we implement hygiene and protection measures to ensure the safety and protection of our guests and at the same time support their well-being.

- If you feel ill or have a suspicion of corona in your immediate surroundings, you can contact us.
   Please stay at home.
- At the reception, a plexiglass screen has been installed and the safety distance of 1.5 meters has been marked on the floor for your orientation. A maximum of two people are allowed at the reception desk.
- Hand disinfectant is available at all necessary places: Reception, access to the seminar room, toilets

- A maximum of two persons may be present in the shared toilets.
- The usual rules of "social distancing" (e.g. avoidance of shaking hands, hugs and kisses) apply. A good moment to start by greeting each other with a bow of honor and "Namasté"!



- Frequently used areas are regularly disinfected.
- The regular ventilation of the seminar room is the responsibility of the seminar organizer.
- Should it not be possible to keep the distance of 1.5 meters due to your course activity, we advise the participants to bring their own masks or to buy them in our store.
- In the dining room there is a cold and warm buffet with protection against spitting drops. The safety distance in the queue has been marked on the floor and guests are encouraged to practice silence while queuing.
- The team is also available to answer any questions, comments or concerns that may arise during your stay with us.

The Federal Office of Public Health (BAG) has defined countries with an increased risk of infection. Current entry and quarantine regulations can be read <a href="https://example.com/here/base/">here</a>.

In the event of cancellation due to non-compliance with the applicable Covid measures, costs will be incurred in accordance with the cancellation conditions.
